Dear Secretary Burgess:

On Friday November 8, the New York Transmission Owners (“NYTOs”) responded by letter to the DPS Staff’s Deficiencies List in Case 13-M-0457. (A copy of the November 8, 2013 letter is attached hereto). In the November 8, 2013 Letter, the NYTOs stated that they intended, by November 27, 2013, to file with the Commission certain information and materials to supplement their Part A submission in the above-referenced proceedings. Accordingly, enclosed please find for filing with the Commission on behalf of the NYTOs electronic and hard copies of the NYTOs Part A supplemental filing (“Supplemental Filing”).

Consistent with the November 8, 2013 Letter, the Supplemental Filing includes:

1. Exhibit 2: A revised Section 2.1 of Exhibit 2 “General Description of National Grid Facility Location” and Exhibit 2 maps 1 through 25 (of 25), dated November, 2013, showing the location of the proposed right-of-way for the Edic to Pleasant Valley transmission line and substation components of the proposed line. Corresponding revisions to Exhibit E-1 are also included. The proposed edge of right-of-way corresponds to the edge of the existing rights-of-way that presently are held by National Grid. It is the intent of the applicant to design the proposed Edic to Pleasant Valley line to be within the existing rights-of-way. However, additional survey, design and engineering analyses still need to be completed to confirm the feasibility of the design. These additional analyses include assessments of costs and of environmental, cultural and societal impacts.



2. Exhibit 7: Revised drawings showing the zoning that applies in the Town of Stark within the right-of way, and the zoning of three other localities that applies within a quarter-mile of the right-of-way centerline.
3. Preliminary Scoping Statements: Revised preliminary scoping statements for several exhibits, including additions to the information required by the Commission's September 19, 2013 order to be included in Exhibit 4 of the Part B submission regarding the method by which studies will be undertaken to address efforts to: (a) minimize the emissions of greenhouse gases during the construction, operation and maintenance of the proposed facility; (b) address system resilience to rising water tables (where underground installation is proposed); (c) address system resilience to flooding and to storm surge in coastal areas; and (d) address the proposed facilities resilience to severe snow and/or ice storms and to periods of extreme heat.

All persons on the service list and all active parties in Case 13-E-0488 were served with an electronic copy on a DVD of the Supplemental Filing and a copy of this letter. The Supplemental Filing is accompanied by proof of such service. The NYTOs by copy of this letter hereby inform each person on the attached service list that a hard copy of the supplemental filing will be provided upon request. Further, the Supplemental Filing will be delivered to the libraries listed on the attached separate list of libraries as part of public outreach for this project, pursuant to the November 8, 2013 Letter paragraph number three (3).

Dear Administrative Law Judges Phillips and Prestemon:

On Friday November 1, the New York Transmission Owners (NYTOs) received DPS Staff's Deficiencies List in Case 13-M-0457. Representatives of the NYTOs consulted extensively with DPS Staff and are providing the following information in response to the Deficiency List.

1. Payment for intervenor fund; 16 NYCRR 85-2.4: An additional intervenor fund payment in the amount of \$350,000 has been sent under cover of separate letter to the Commission.

2. Service of application; 16 NYCRR 85-2.10 (a): The Part A Application has been served upon Christopher S. Friend, NYS Assembly district 124. The affidavit of service is attached to this letter (Attachment 1).

3. Notice of application—Additional notice; 16 NYCRR 85-2.10 (d): If the presiding officers direct the NYTOs to provide notice of the application to interested parties, the NYTOs have no objection to providing such notice, and, if so directed, a list of interested parties will be provided to DPS Staff for consultation purposes. As part of the outreach on the Application and as suggested by DPS Staff, attached is a list of the libraries that either have received or will receive a copy of the Part A Application (Attachment 2).

4. Notice of the application, newspaper publication, proof of service; 16 NYCRR 85-2.10(c): Attached are the proofs of publication from each periodical in which notice was published (Attachment 3).

5. Exhibit 2: Location of Facilities: 16 NYCRR 86.3 (a)(1)(i): The Applicant will provide a revised version of Exhibit 2 containing a description of the proposed Edic to Pleasant Valley Line and revised Exhibit 2 drawings showing the limits of the right-of-way and indicating where additional right-of-way may be necessary. The revised Exhibit 2 including the revised drawings will be filed and served on or before November 27, 2013.

6. Exhibit 7: Local ordinances; 16 NYCRR 86.8 (4):

- a. For the Second Oakdale to Fraser line, the affected localities were identified by overlaying the proposed ROW on the NYS Municipal layer (downloaded from the NYSGIS Clearinghouse), in both cases using GIS digital data. A spatial query was then created to identify the borders of all the localities intersected by the proposed ROW.
- b. For the Edic to Pleasant Valley line, the affected localities were identified through a GIS spatial query against a merged locality data set. Digital data for the zoning and floodplain/floodway areas in the localities crossed were not available from every locality, and in such cases, GIS was used to generate digital data for a half mile wide corridor centered on the proposed route for the required digital data. For zoning data needs, hard copy maps obtained from the relevant localities were scanned and GIS was used to geo-reference the scanned maps and digitize the necessary data. For floodplain/floodway areas where digital data was not available, the FEMA website was used to generate PDFs (also known as FEMA "FIRMettes") of applicable maps, which were then geo-referenced and the necessary data was digitized.
- c. All zoning information available to the Applicant was provided in Exhibit 7. The Town of Stark initially indicated that no zoning law existed in the Town. Upon further consultation with the Town Attorney and the Town Clerk, it appears that zoning does exist in the Town. On or before November 27, 2013, revised drawings showing the zoning that applies in the Town of Stark within the right-of-way will be filed and served.


7. Scoping Statement: No specific deficiencies were identified with respect to the NYTOs scoping statement. Based on consultation with DPS Staff, the discussion in the Exhibit 4 Preliminary Scoping Statement will be expanded to address the method by which studies will be undertaken to address efforts a) to minimize the emissions of greenhouse gases during the construction, operation and maintenance of the proposed facility; b) to address system resilience to rising water tables (where underground installation is proposed); c) to address system resilience to flooding and to storm surge in coastal areas; and d) to address the proposed facility's resilience to severe snow and/or ice storms and to periods of extreme heat. The

amended scoping statement will be filed and served on or before November 27, 2013 to address each of these subjects as described in the September Order.

8. Public Outreach: No deficiencies were identified with respect to the NYTOs website. The web address--www.nytransco.com--will be prominently displayed in any supplemental filings and the website has been and will be continuously updated as more information is available. A summary of public outreach efforts to date was previously provided to DPS Staff under separate cover by each NYTO.

The NYTOs look forward to working with DPS Staff and Your Honors to ensure that their Part A application is complete so that the scoping process can move forward.
